Internet access is free to library members.
Non-members are charged €3.00 per half hour.

What am I entitled to borrow?

- Adult – 8 items
- Children – 6 items
- Family – 20 items.

The standard loan period is 3 weeks. This may be extended, either in person, on the telephone or online, if the item is not requested by another borrower.

You can also view your account details and renew and reserve items. Ask Staff for PIN number.

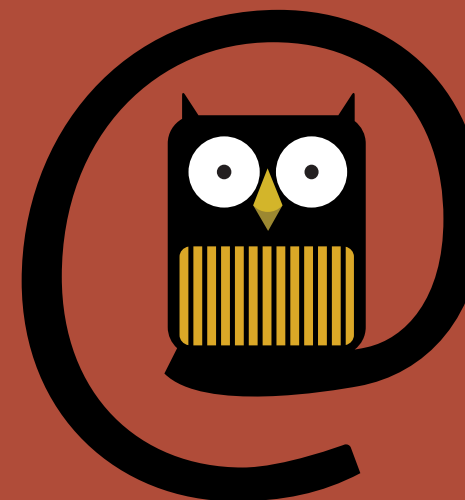
If an item you require is not in stock and you are a library member, you can request it through your local branch or through the national **Public Library Network** in Ireland at www.borrowbooks.ie
